Happy New Year and a warm welcome back to everyone! The Year 4 teachers are Mrs Portergill (Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays) and Mrs Stimpson (Tuesdays and Wednesdays). Also working in the classroom are Mrs Davies and Mrs Kraja.

<u>PE</u>

PE will be on a **Wednesdays** (indoor) and **Thursday** (outdoor). Children should come dressed in their PE kit (white t-shirt, black, navy or royal blue shorts and trainers with their school jumper) on their PE days. Jogging bottoms may be worn for outdoor PE.

Homework

The **spelling** pattern and a selection of activities to practise the pattern will be sent out on a **Monday**. We test the spellings through a written activity, practising the application of the words on the **Friday**.

In Year 4 in the **summer term,** the children will be **tested nationally on their times tables**. The children are given a weekly tables test alongside lessons to learn them. In order to improve their skills, we suggest a daily times table practice (5x a week) on **TT Rockstars**. All the class have their logins in their Reading Records.

Children are expected to **read each night** and have Reading Records to record this in. Please make sure you sign the record every time they read. There are certificates and books to be won for regular reading.

You will shortly receive a **humanities homework sheet**. We ask that the children choose **four** of the tasks to do in depth. They are expected to bring the work in by the **13.3.23**. They will show and explain their homework to the class. Homework can also be sent in on Class Dojo.
