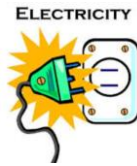


Numeracy

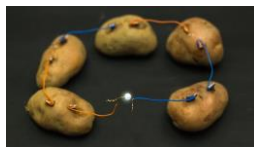
Expressive Arts
